The Children's Division (3-5 years old)



The Children's Division provides classroom and recital opportunities for students between the ages of 3-5 years old. Students must be potty trained prior to the first day of the semester to participate in classes. Combination Ballet and Tap classes allow children as young as three years of age to experience the joy and physical benefits of a dance class. Imagination and story telling through dance is emphasized using guided, creative and age-appropriate activities. Activities to develop

coordination body awareness, and ballet and tap class discipline are present of each class. Students in the Children's Division Program have the opportunity to perform in the Holiday and Annual Recitals.

Class Attire and Dress Code

Ballet Attire for Pre-professional Ballet Division: In keeping with the classical ballet tradition and to achieve a uniformity of appearance within class levels, LDT requires students to comply with the following Dress Code.

Girls:

- 1) Any style solid black leotard or the Ballet Recital Blue/Purple Leotard with attached skirt, no unattached skirts for Ballet Levels 1-4, Level 5-7 skirts during pointe class only
- 2) Pink canvas or leather ballet slippers with drawstring bows tucked in, pointe shoes, where applicable which must be properly fitted by Boulder Body Wear
- 3) Hair must be in a secure bun, away from the neck and face/
no swinging ponytails
- 4) Full Footed Tights: Levels 1-4: Ballet Pink, Bloch Endura tights (not seamed), can come in convertible and non-convertible
Level 5-7: Ballet Pink, Bloch seamed adaptatoc convertible tights
Available sizes: Child A (4-5), B (6-8), or C (10-12) &
Adult Endura: A, B, C, or D

Boys:

White t-shirt, socks (white preferred), black leather/canvas ballet slippers, dark colored (black preferred) jazz/yoga pants, shorts or tights

Tap/Jazz: Tap is a dance in which the rhythm is sounded out by the clicking taps on the heels and toes of a dancer's shoes. Jazz is any of various dances characterized by the use of improvisation and influenced by rhythms and techniques of jazz music

Girls:

- 1) Leotard of any style and color
- 2) Tan non-shiny tights
- 3) Lycra jazz pants or lycra bike shorts
- 4) Black tap and/or black jazz shoes
- 5) No baggy clothes, sneakers, or jeans
- 6) Hair pulled back from face and neck

Boys:

- 1) T-shirt of any color
- 2) Black/white socks
- 3) Lycra jazz pants or lycra bike shorts
- 4) Black tap and/or black jazz shoes
- 5) No baggy clothes, sneakers, or jeans

Hip Hop: This form of dance can include a wide range of styles such as breaking, popping, locking, house dance and even electro-dance.

Girls and Boys: Leotard or shirt with loose fitting pants, white plain flat bottom tennis shoes (Shoes must not be worn outside. This prevents damage to LDT's studio flooring from glass, rocks, pebbles, or disease.) Hair must be pulled back from face and neck (No skirts, no shorts, no half shirts, no jazz shoes, and no jazz sneakers will be accepted)

Modern: This free flowing movement utilizes weight shifts and proper alignment while promoting breath during movement.

Girls:

- 1) Leotard of any style and color
- 2) Any color footless tights
- 3) No shoes or socks
- 4) Hair pulled back from face and neck
- 5) Loose or tight fitting capris or pants

Boys:

- 1) T-shirt of any color
- 2) Loose fitting pants (no jeans)
- 3) No shoes or socks

Flamenco: A dance of Spanish origin that uses strong rhythmic music and emphasizes footwork and upper body movement.

Girls:

- 1) Leotard of any style and color
- 2) Any color tights (no jeans)
- 3) Flamenco shoes and skirt
- 4) Hair pulled back from face and neck

Boys:

- 1) T-shirt of any color
- 2) Loose fitting pants (no jeans)
- 3) No shoes or socks
